

Group Tubing FAQs and Rates

Please call 413-442-8985 or email <u>info@bousquetmountain.com</u> with any questions or to book your group tubing event. A 50% deposit is required at the time of booking, and the remainder due 72 hours prior to arrival with your final count of tubers.

Once reserved, if the number of participants increases or decreases at any time, please let us know as soon as possible. We may not be able to increase the number of group or semi-private tubers since we sell the remaining tickets in the time slot to the public. There is a minimum of 15 tubers required to qualify for any group rate pricing below.

Group Ticket Rate: Available for groups of 15 - 40 people

Includes: 1.5 hours of tubing during a pre-scheduled timeslot at a discounted daily rate

Details: Participants must be 42" tall and be able to ride their tube independently, there are no kids allowed on tubes with parents or guardians. Each participant will need a signed waiver to participate. Minors need a waiver signed by their parent/guardian.

Bousquet will book the remaining tickets in the time slot to members of the public. You will not have reserved lanes or private access to the cabana village. We can add tickets to your reservation pending availability but will not sell over 80 tickets for any time slot (a combination of group tickets and public tickets). Group ticket rates not available during holiday periods.

Cost:

- Midweek: \$20.00 per person, minimum 15 people, max 40 people
- Non-holiday weekend: \$26.00, minimum 15 people, max 40 people

Add-Ons:

• \$79 gets you **2 private cabanas** that are located next to Tube Town, **a dedicated fire pit**, and **private picnic tables** depending on the size of your group.

Semi-Private Tubing Party: Available for 15 - 50 participants

Includes: 1.5 hours of tubing during a pre-scheduled timeslot with dedicated tubing lanes for the members of your party (up to 6 lanes depending on the number of lanes available).

Details: Participants must be 42" tall and be able to ride their tube independently, there are no kids allowed on tubes with parents or guardians. Each participant will need a waiver to participate. Minors need a waiver signed by their parent/guardian.

Bousquet will book the remaining 20 tubing tickets to members of the public at the regular rate, but they will not have access to your tubing lanes. We can add tickets to your reservation pending availability but will not sell over 70 tickets for any time slot. Semi-private reservations and rates not available during holiday periods.

Cost:

- Midweek: \$20 per person, minimum 15 people
- Non-holiday weekend: \$26 per person, minimum 15 people

Add-Ons:

• \$79 gets you **2 private cabanas** that are located next to Tube Town, **a dedicated fire pit**, and **private picnic tables** depending on the size of your group.

Private Tubing Area: Available for 50 - 100 participants

Includes: 1.5 hours of tubing during a pre-scheduled timeslot where your group has dedicated access to Tube Town. No tickets will be sold to the public.

Details: Participants must be 42" tall and be able to ride their tube independently, there are no kids allowed on tubes with parents or guardians. Each participant will need a waiver to participate. Minors need a waiver signed by their parent/guardian. There is a required 50-person minimum on weekdays and 70-person minimum on non-holiday weekends to book a private reservation. Private tubing reservations not available during holiday periods.

Cost:

Midweek: \$20/person, minimum 50 peopleWeekend: \$24/person, minimum 70 people

Add-Ons:

• \$129 includes exclusive access to the Tube Town Cabana Village and picnic table area (2 cabanas, 3 fire pits, and 8 picnic tables) reserved for your group.

Policies and Tube Town Rules:

Refunds/Cancellations:

Please know that we will operate when it's raining, cold, or snowing during the winter and we cannot guarantee the weather on any given day, especially when your reservation is booked in advance. You agree to accept the possibility that the weather may not be ideal on the day of your scheduled event, but if we are open, we are not able to refund or reschedule your event.

Tubing tickets and any tubing group reservations are date and time specific and non-transferrable and non-refundable except in the following circumstance:

- You cancel a full 72 hours in advance of your reservation
- The mountain closes for any reason and the guest is unable to use or reschedule their ticket to a new date

No group, semi-private, or private reservations are available during holiday dates. The 2025/26 holiday dates are:

- 12/26/25 1/2/26
- 1/15/26 1/19/26
- 2/14/26 2/22/26

Tube Town Rules:

- One person per tube
- Must be over 42" and able to ride their tube independently without a parent or guardian
- Must be sitting on tube no belly, standing or kneeling riders
- · Make sure the lane is clear before going
- Start your run ONLY when instructed to do so
- No one under the influence is allowed to tube
- No ski boots allowed
- No running starts
- Clear the run-out area as quickly as possible ask for help if needed
- No tubing when the tube park is closed
- Lastly, and most importantly, HAVE FUN!
