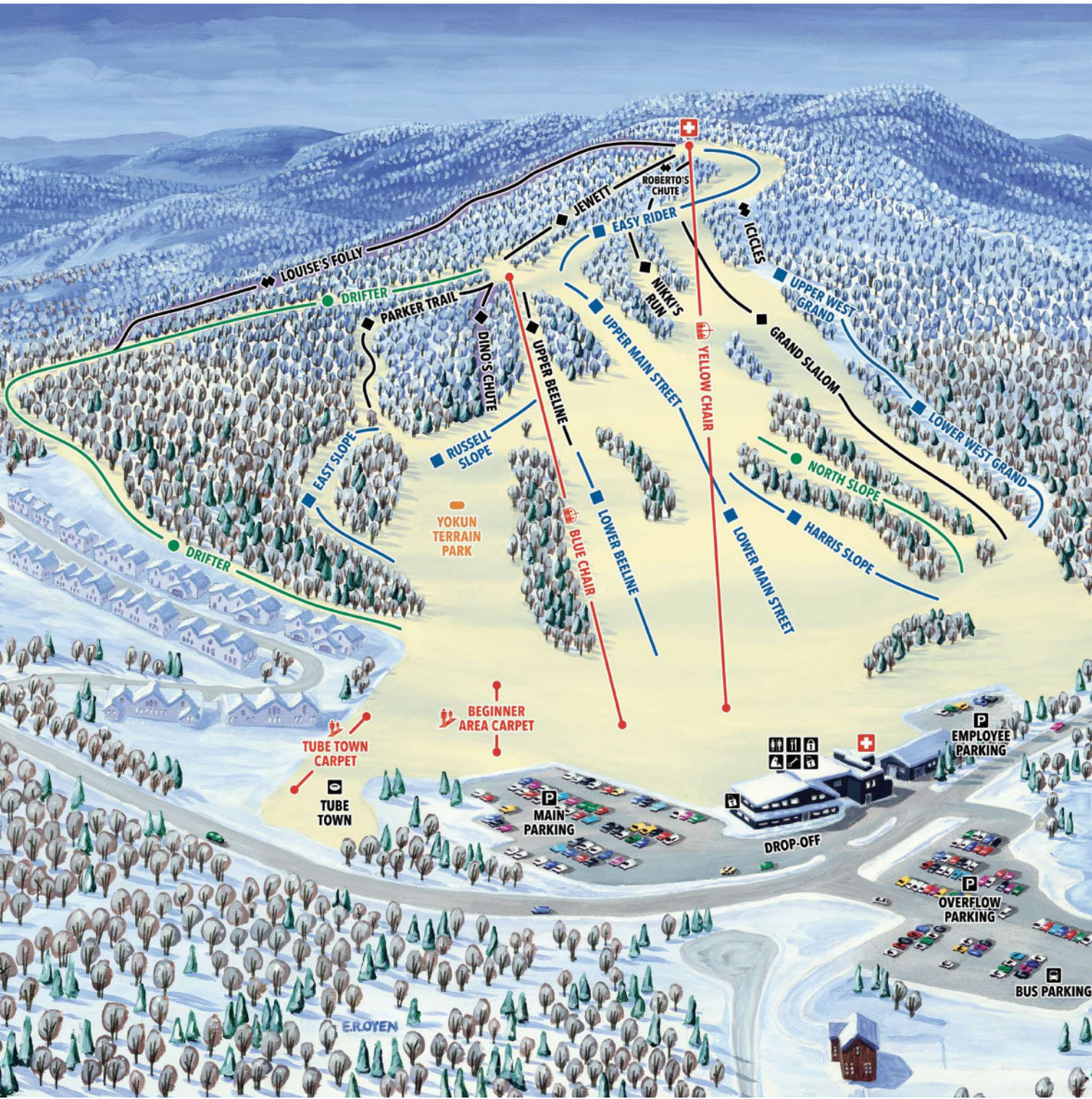

## ALPINE RESPONSIBILITY CODE



Skilling rules are enforced in every area. All skiers must use every one of the following rules to help ensure a safe skiing experience. These rules are the responsibility of every skier. Obeying the rules helps ensure a safe skiing experience.

1. Always stay in control and be able to stop at any time.
2. Prepare yourself before you start. Know the rules, the terrain, and the weather. Know your own abilities and the abilities of others.
3. You must not stop where you can obstruct a trail or cut across the path of others.
4. Whenever stopping, dismount or step aside to let others pass.
5. Always use devices to help prevent runaway equipment.
6. Observe all posted signs and warnings. They are there for your safety and the safety of others.
7. Prior to using any lift, you must know the knowledge and ability to load, ride and unload safely.
